



SAH Medical Chaperone Consent Form

The Oregon Medical Board is now requiring that all OMB licensees offer a trained chaperone to be physically present during all genital, rectal and breast exams “sensitive exams” beginning July 1, 2023 per [OAR 847-010-0130](#).

It is the policy of St. Anthony Hospital and its affiliates to offer the presence of a trained chaperone for all sensitive examinations to all populations, regardless of age or gender identity. We will do everything possible to accommodate patient preferences.
